## Alternative Learning Programme

Is a 6 to 8-week, non-formal short term response programme for young people who are aged between 12 years to 15 years who are at risk of leaving school early. Participants are credited with self-directed achievement and positive outcomes, by focusing on their attendance, punctuality, messaging, participation, contribution, checking and following instruction.
